Dawn Berkowitz is the current Chief of Federal and Special Tobacco Control Initiatives for the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene where she has worked with the tobacco control program for nearly 12 years. During her tenure there she provided guidance in 1999 and 2000 to the Governor's Task Force to End Smoking in Maryland which formed the legislative and programmatic framework for Master Settlement Agreement dollars coming into Maryland and worked to form the current structure of Maryland's resulting tobacco control program.

In addition to other statewide tobacco control initiatives, Ms. Berkowitz oversees tobacco control media efforts and the Maryland Tobacco Quitline. She also served as a reviewer for the 2004 CDC Telephone Quitlines: A Resource for Development, Implementation, and Evaluation Guide prior to publication.
