Wheeling Jesuit University – 1,200 students, no smoking campus dorms or buildings

West Liberty University – 2,600 students, no smoking campus dorms or buildings

West Virginia University – 28,000 students, no smoking campus dorms or buildings

Potomac State College – 1,700 students, all dorms tobacco free

Shepherd University – 4,400 students, no tobacco in campus dorms, buildings bleachers or within 25 feet of facilities

Davis and Elkins College – 710 students, no smoking in dorms or buildings, smokeless tobacco must be disposed in proper trash receptacles

WV Wesleyan College – 1,400 students, tied into United Methodist Church

Ohio Valley University – 582 students, tobacco free campus but have one smoking area, tied into the Church of Christ

WVU at Parkersburg – 3,750 students, tobacco free dorms and buildings

WV State University – 7,000 students, dorms are smoke free

Fairmont State University – 7,700 students, tobacco free dorms and buildings, No smoking within 20 feet of entrances, or standing in line or waiting crowds

Institute of Technology WVU – 1,588 students, “Smoking and smokeless tobacco use is prohibited in indoor locations where tobacco users and non-smokers share the same area. The rights of the non-smoker will prevail” No tobacco use in dorms or within 25 feet of dorm.

Marshall University – 14,000 students, dorms and buildings smoke free

Concord University – 3,000 students “Smoking is only permitted in a student’s private room (when the student does not live on a substance free floor), with the door shut, and with prior consent of his or her roommate(s).” In case of conflict University will support position of non-smoker.

Bluefield State College – 2,838 no dorms tobacco free buildings

Mountain State University – 5,000 students, dorms and buildings tobacco free

No schools are completely tobacco free.
