

SUGGESTED TOBACCO-RELATED Coordinated School-Public Health Partnership (CSPHP) Work for FY2012

The following scope of work is suggested to outline several potential objectives and activities that would comprise the tobacco prevention and cessation efforts of the CSPHP during FY2012. This is presented as a suggested list of tobacco-related work that could be added to a collaborative grant agreement between the WV Department of Education and the DHHR / BPH supportive of the CSPHP.
