

Oregon Releases Request For Information (RFI) 2676

The Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) is gathering information relating to Tobacco Quitline services and has just released a Request for Information (RFI). Information on call systems, counseling services, Web-based services and data collection and evaluation will assist DHS in developing requirements for a solicitation for Tobacco Quitline services. Written information must be received by DHS on or before April 1, 2008 at 2:00PM Pacific Time. DHS intends to conduct telephone interviews with respondents April 10-18, 2008.

Quitline services are funded by a combination of state and federal funds and served approximately 6,200 smokers in Oregon in 2007. DHS is seeking information about products and services currently in existence and about how the implementation of services can be expanded and adapted in the future. DHS is open to alternative service design and delivery ideas and is seeking broad and innovative information to help with forming a long-term service delivery, service development and evaluation plan.
