- CDC <u>released</u> a series of new videos that encourage smokers to utilize quitlines as a resource to help quit smoking.
- ChangeLab Solutions in collaboration with other public health organizations <u>published</u> a model Tobacco 21 policy that emphasizes the role of retailers that profit on tobacco products instead of young adult consumers.
- The Public Health Law Center <u>updated</u> their 50state review of tobacco policies and how they relate to the definition and regulation of e-cigarettes.
- The Smoking Cessation Leadership
 Center is <u>waiving</u> the CEU cost associated with their 2016 and 2017 collection of webinars.

State News

- <u>Maryland</u> and <u>Vermont</u> became the 13th and 14th states to raise the tobacco purchase age to 21 after each state's governor signed bills into law.
- The North Carolina attorney general <u>became</u> the first to file a lawsuit against JUUL Labs, alleging that the company marketed towards youth and is responsible for the epidemic of e-cigarette use among minors.
- Beverly Hills, California would be the first municipality to prohibit the sale of all tobacco

 JUUL Labs <u>announced</u> that it will be opening a new assembly facility in **South Carolina**, a move that has been met with both support and concern.

In the News

- Sens. Mitch McConnell and Tim Kaine <u>introduced</u> the Tobacco-Free Youth Act, a bill that would raise the age for purchasing tobacco control to 21 nationwide. Contrary to McConnell's initial <u>announcement</u>, the bill does not exempt those who served in the military.
- In a lawsuit brought by national public health groups, a federal judge <u>ruled</u> that FDA's decision to allow e-cigarettes and other new tobacco products on the market without review until 2022 represents an "abdication of statutory responsibilities." FDA has two weeks to submit a new plan of action.
- Doctors and public health researchers are <u>critical</u> of JUUL's multimedia advertising campaign and are calling for restrictions comparable to what producers of combustible tobacco products face.
- Altria Chairman and CEO Howard Willard III <u>shared</u> during the company's annual shareholders meeting that investments in the ecigarette and cannabis industries are positioning Altria for future growth.

graders reported exposure to secondhand ecigarette aerosol in public places, with exposure being associated with increased susceptibility to use e-cigarettes and combustible cigarettes.

 A Nicotine & Tobacco Research analysis of PATH study data <u>concluded</u> that cannabis use is positive correlated with cigarette smoking initiation among non-smokers, and is negatively correlated with smoking cessation among existing smokers.
