## **Partner Announcements**

- A CDC analysis of 2019 Youth Risk Behavior
  Survey data published in an MMWR found that in
  2019, 32.7% of high school students reported being
  current e-cigarette users, and 36.5% were current
  users of any tobacco product.
- A press release from six leading tobacco control groups calls on FDA to not authorize the sale of any flavored tobacco product, citing evidence that such products appeal disproportionately to underage consumers and that they don't help adult smokers quit.
- A new ASPIRE Center study that mapped tobacco retailers in 30 American cities found that 63% of urban public schools are located within 1,000 feet of a tobacco retailer, and that retailers are disproportionately located in lower income areas. Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids published a study summary and a social media toolkit that includes tailored graphics for all 30 cities in the study.
- NACCHO <u>published</u> a recording of its recent webinar, "Tobacco in Rural America: Reports from the Field," which featured speakers from NNPHI and the Muskie School at the University of Southern Maine.

- The following tobacco cessation announcements come from ALA:
  - ALA <u>updated</u> its listings of presentations, resources, and toolkits that collectively provide technical assistance on the adoption of effective tobacco cessation policies.
  - ALA launched revised facilitator training courses for its <u>N-O-T Not on</u> <u>Tobacco</u> youth cessation program and its <u>INDEPTH</u> school suspension alternative program.
- A recent episode of the NAATPN podcast "Black Body Health" features Dr. Phillip Gardiner and Carol McGruder from the African American Tobacco Control Leadership Council discussing how menthol tobacco products have harmed Black Americans.
- Truth Initiative <u>published</u> an in-depth article outlining why the marketing and sale of tobacco products is a racial justice issue, highlighting how the tobacco industry targeted Black Americans in their marketing of menthol cigarettes.
- FDA posted new resources to help tobacco product manufacturers submit required premarket review applications before the Sept. 9 deadline.

#### State News

- The Colorado Sun reports that Altria helped write the question that will appear on the 2020 ballot in Colorado to increase tobacco product taxes, perhaps to gain a competitive edge over competitors that sell lower priced cigarettes.
- According to a Minnesota Department of Health news release, the state public health laboratory <u>identified</u> vitamin E acetate in elicit TCH

# About the Tobacco Control Network

The TCN is a network of tobacco program managers and staff

vaping products associated with a recent EVALI outbreak in the state.

- New Hampshire Governor Chris Sununu <u>signed</u> an omnibus bill into law that includes a provision increasing the sales and possession age of all tobacco products from 19 to 21.
- Washington State Attorney General Bob
  Ferguson <u>filed</u> a lawsuit against E-Juice Vapors,
  alleging that the company violated state law by
  marketing products appealing to youth and selling
  products without proper age verification.
- Missouri Governor Mike Parson signed several bills into law, including a policy that will prohibit the use of e-cigarettes in and around public schools and school buses as of Aug. 28.

# In the News

- Federal lawmakers <u>sent</u> a letter to FDA commissioner Stephen Hahn, <u>asking</u> him to indicate whether he will temporarily remove ecigarette products from the market due to their potential impacts on the COVID-19 pandemic.
- JUUL Labs <u>announced</u> that it initiated efforts to stop retailers selling large quantities of fake JUUL products, indicating that it may file as many as 20 lawsuits in coming months.
- An episode of the Business Insider podcast "BTYB Uncut" overviews the history of cigarette marketing, highlighting how Marlboro cigarettes were originally advertised to women before they came to be represented by cowboys.
- According to new research <u>published</u> in *JAMA* Pediatrics, 44.5% of youths aged 12 to 17 who use e-cigarette products reported that they're seriously

 A federal appeals court in Florida <u>ruled</u> that RJ Reynolds is obligated to continue annual Master Settlement Agreement payments on Kool, Maverick, Salem, and Winston brands after the company divested from those brands to purchase former rival Lorillard.

### Research

- An analysis of online survey data published in Journal of Adolescent Health concluded that among American youth and young adults aged 13 to 24, COVID-19 diagnosis was five times more likely among ever users of e-cigarettes and 6.8 times more likely among current e-cigarette users compared to those who never used tobacco products.
- A Preventive Medicine analysis of young Americans aged 15 to 21 found that a dose-response relationship exists between exposure to tobacco imagery on Netflix or television and e-cigarette initiation during the one-year study period.
- A 16-year longitudinal study published in JAMA
   Network Open found that 52.5% of adults 50 and
   under hospitalized with myocardial infarction were
   smokers at the time they were hospitalized. In
   addition, successful smoking cessation reduced all cause mortality and cardiovascular mortality across
   a median 11.2-year follow-up period.
