Partner Announcements

- ASTHO <u>published</u> a narrated presentation based on the TCN virtual deskside briefing that featured Traci Kennedy from the Americans Nonsmokers' Rights Foundation sharing best practices on how to encourage tribal and non-tribal casinos to adopt voluntary smokefree policies.
- CDC and FDA <u>collaborated</u> on a research correspondence published in *The New England Journal of Medicine* which highlights disposable ecigarettes as an emerging public health challenge for youth.
- Public Health Law Center <u>published</u> a copy of the citizen petition supplement it submitted to FDA this past January, which outlines in great detail why the agency should prohibit menthol as an additive to cigarettes.
- Truth Initiative published a <u>report</u> on the detrimental impacts of e-cigarette waste on the environment and launched an <u>informational web</u> <u>page</u> on flavored tobacco polices.
- FDA <u>announced</u> that it sent an additional 13 warning letters to e-cigarette manufacturers for illegally marketing products without submitting the required premarket tobacco product applications.
 FDA also <u>announced</u> that it sent four letters to ecigarette manufacturers to request more information about their social media practices.
- In recognition of International Women's Day, Action on Smoking and Health <u>shared</u> a popular TikTok video documenting historical

State News

- A CDC-led analysis of JUUL pods collected from 16 California high schools published in *Journal of Adolescent Health* found that 24 of 26 pods collected had a nicotine concentration outside the prediction intervals based on advertised 3% and 5% concentrations.
- An editorial in *The Salt Lake Tribune overviews* how tobacco retailers have been able to circumnavigate **Utah** state laws intended to reduce retailer density near schools.

Research

- An analysis of Youth Risk Behavior Survey data published in *Tobacco Control* <u>found</u> that state level ecigarette inclusive smoke-free policies were associated with a decrease in youth e-cigarette prevalence between 2017 and 2019.
- A *Tobacco Control* modeling estimate of the harms attributable to menthol cigarettes in the United States <u>concluded</u> that between 1980 to 2018, menthol use was responsible for slowing the decline of cigarette use prevalence by 2.6%, resulting in 10.1 million extra smokers, three million life years lost, and 378,000 premature deaths.
- A Nicotine and Tobacco Research analysis of crosssectoral multi-site data from the Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System <u>found</u> that from 2016 to 2017, 1.1% of pregnant women in 38 states used e-cigarettes in the final three months of their pregnancy, 62.3% of whom were dual users of tobacco products.

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
