- Truth Initiative made the following announcements:
  - A new Truth Initiative app, developed in partnership with Breathwrk, <u>leads</u> users through three custom designed breathing exercises to help reduce anxiety and ease cravings while quitting vaping.
  - Truth Initiative <u>published</u> a tip sheet on how vaping adversely impacts productivity in the healthcare workplace.
- Updated data and features are now <u>available</u> on the County Health Rankings website, which includes tobacco use prevalence alongside many other datapoints on health behaviors, health outcomes, socioeconomic factors, and more.

#### **State News**

- The North Dakota Senate <u>rejected</u> a bill that would have permitted cigar bars as an exemption to the state's Indoor Clean Air Act.
- A Health & Place analysis of historical redlining in 13 Ohio cities found an association between redlining and present-day tobacco retailer density after controlling for sociodemographic characteristics.
- West Virginia governor Jim Justice <u>signed</u> into law
  a policy that starting this June will require all new
  county health regulations, including tobacco control
  policies, to be approved by a county commission or
  other appointed county-level board.

# About the Tobacco Control Network

The TCN's mission is to improve the public's health by providing education and state-based expertise to tobacco prevention and control at the state and national levels.

The TCN is a network of tobacco program managers and staff from state and territorial health departments as  An exposé on menthol cigarettes from The New York Times details the consequences of menthol cigarettes in terms of health inequities and racial injustice, and overviews opportunities for FDA and federal lawmakers to prohibit the sale of those products nationwide.

### Research

- A Nicotine & Tobacco Research analysis of young adult (ages 18-35) tobacco users concluded that tobacco advertisement warnings over a yellow background were rated as more attention grabbing than those over a white background, and also were associated with greater message recall.
- A special communication published in *Tobacco Control* <u>outlines</u> how the reduced exposure marketing order FDA issued for IQOS products in the United States disregarded scientific evidence and has been utilized by Philip Morris International in marketing and public relations campaigns internationally.
- A Tobacco Control analysis of prior studies on the nicotine content of JUUL pods found that pods advertised to have 40 mg of nicotine ranged from 39.3 to 48.3 mg, resulting in total nicotine delivery comparable to a pack of 20 cigarettes.
