## Research

- A Nicotine & Tobacco Research data analysis of ecigarette product use among young adults <u>found</u> that the use of disposable e-cigarettes was most common among current users of nondisposable e-cigarette products, followed by former users of those products, and then young adults who never used those products.
- A Nicotine & Tobacco Research randomized control
  trial comparing a text message intervention to a
  standard of care among youth experiencing
  homelessness <u>found</u> that the intervention led to
  reductions in tobacco product use, as well as in
  other health indicators such as drinking and
  symptoms of anxiety and depression.
