# **Partner Announcements**

- CDC published findings from the 2021 National Youth Tobacco Survey (NYTS) in an MMWR detailing that 11.3% of high school students and 2.8% of middle school students reported current (last 30-day) e-cigarette use, with approximately 85% of students preferring flavored products. Though this compares favorably to the 19.6% high school prevalence and 4.7% middle school prevalence from the 2020 NYTS, CDC recommends not making direct comparisons because of changes in data collection for the 2021 NYTS related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- ASTHO <u>updated</u> its Responding to Emerging
   Challenges in Tobacco Control technical assistance
   package by adding a recording from the recent
   virtual panel discussion: The Way Forward:
   Sustaining and Amplifying Tobacco Cessation
   Strategies.
- The following announcements come from FDA:
  - Since the court-ordered deadline of Sept. 9, FDA twice <u>updated</u> its listing of marketing denial orders resulting from premarket tobacco product applications for e-cigarette products. FDA subsequently <u>issued</u> 20 warning letters to companies that continued selling their products after receiving an order.
  - FDA's Population Assessment of Tobacco and Health Study <u>released</u> its fifth wave of data for youth adults.

   <u>Applications</u> and the other relating to <u>Substantial Equivalence</u> applications.
- FDA released two new webinar recordings, including an overview of warning letters sent to online retailers and how the Office of Small Business Assistance provides technical assistance to tobacco manufacturers and businesses.
- The following announcements come from Truth Initiative:
  - Truth Initiative <u>launched</u> a youth ecigarette education effort, "It's Messing with Our Heads," to spread messaging on the connection between nicotine and anxiety and depression among youth.
  - A Truth Initiative web
     page <u>overviews</u> research indicating that e cigarette use can harm mental health.
  - Truth Initiative interviewed Tamanna Patel, director of the National Behavioral Health Network for Tobacco and Cancer Control, to discuss the connection between youth vaping and mental health.
- An ALA blog post <u>discusses</u> a documentary from teen Cole Kosch, which presents first-hand interviews on the dangers and emotional impact of vaping among youth.

The TCN is a network of tobacco program managers and staff from state and territorial health departments as well as Funder's Alliance organizations, and a peer group of the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials (ASTHO) on behalf of the CDC's Office on Smoking and Health.

- San Jose, California became the largest U.S. city to pass a comprehensive flavored tobacco sales restriction, inclusive of menthol cigarettes, with a policy that comes into effect in July 2022.
- The City Council in Atlantic City <u>passed</u> a resolution in support of **New Jersey** Senate Bill 1878, which would prohibit smoking in Atlantic City casinos.
- Three gas stations
   are <u>suing</u> Brookline, **Massachusetts** over its recent
   ban on the sale of tobacco products to anyone born
   on or after Jan. 1, 2000.

### In the News

- In a recent Bloomberg editorial, Michael Bloomberg <u>criticizes</u> FDA for failing to remove popular brands of high-nicotine and mentholflavored products from store shelves.
- E-cigarette manufacturers are <u>struggling</u> to remain on the market following FDA's recent decisions to deny nearly 300 companies' marketing order applications, removing millions of flavored products from the market.
- A Tobacco Control editorial <u>calls</u> for the removal of menthol cigarettes from the market, citing their role in disproportionate death and disease burdens shouldered by African Americans as a result of predatory industry marketing.

#### Research

 A Nicotine & Tobacco Research systematic review <u>found</u> that local laws restricting the sale of flavored tobacco products achieved intended outcomes, such as the reduced availability of those products, but that more rigorous study designs could strengthen the evidence base.

- A Tobacco Control simulation model <u>estimates</u> that menthol cigarettes are responsible for 1.5 million new smokers, 157,000 smoking-related premature deaths, and 1.5 million life-years lost among African Americans between 1980 and 2018.
- An experiment of adult cigarette smokers published in Nicotine & Tobacco Research concluded that visual attention to the FDA logo played an important role in subjects' attitudes towards the agency's "Every Try Counts" campaign.
- A Nicotine & Tobacco Research evaluation of the SmokefreeVET text message cessation program tailored to military veterans <u>found</u> that the program was more effective for users of smokeless tobacco than cigarettes in leading to 30-day abstinence at six-month follow-up.
