Integrating Synar and Tobacco Retail Licensing

Deadline: Sept. 23

OR recently passed legislation to create a tobacco retail licensing system (TRL). Now that they will have a statewide retail list and enforcement inspection system, they are exploring how to integrate Synar survey sampling into routine enforcement inspections.

OR wants to learn from other states who have already integrated Synar with their TRL. Things they are interested in learning are:

- How has your state pulled the Synar sample and integrating that sample with your routine underage sales enforcement?
- Do you use the same protocol for inspections between Synar and enforcement?

- Do you cite or warn retailers or clerks who sell tobacco as part of Synar? If you do, how do you minimize the risk of bias to the survey results from retailers alerting each other to the presence of the survey team?
- How do you conduct Synar surveys so they do not alert retailers the survey team is in the area when you are also conducting underage sales enforcement?

Tobacco Harm Perception Campaigns

Deadline: Sept. 27

The proportion of VT high school students vaping marijuana increased eight-fold in 2019 (17%) compared to 2017 (2%). With the perceived risk of harm from marijuana among students decreasing and substance use initiation with cannabis on the rise, VT is interested in hearing how states are messaging to youth and young adults to prevent the erosion of perception of harm of tobacco.

Please share with VT any media campaigns or public messaging that communicates:

- Health consequences of vaping any substance
- Risk of tobacco and cannabis dual-use
- Harms of smoking tobacco and cannabis

Examples of collaboration with substance use prevention partners are also welcome.

 - FDA issued Marketing Denial Orders on over 90% of more than 6.5 million deemed tobacco products applications, many of which failed to provide evidence that the products' potential benefits for adult smokers outweigh the known risks for youth.
 - FDA <u>released</u> progress updates on the review of applications for deemed new tobacco products submitted by the Sept. 9 deadline.
 - FDA <u>created</u> a web page with general information and resources related to the submission of tobacco product applications and implementation of the Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act.

 SB. 395, a bill which imposes a 12.5% sales tax on e-cigarette products, <u>passed</u> both the Senate and Assembly of the **California** legislature.

In the News

- FDA <u>announced</u> that it will be delaying action on whether Juul's vaping products, which account for 40% of the e-cigarette market, can remain on the market.
- A special communication published in *Tobacco Control* discusses FDA tobacco product regulations and other tobacco control measures through the lens of racial equity and social justice for Black communities in the United States.

Research

- An analysis of U.S. adult survey data published in *Drug and Alcohol Review* found that relative harm perceptions of e-cigarettes were negatively associated with odds of ever seeking information on using e-cigarettes for smoking cessation.
- An analysis of Population Assessment of Tobacco and Health Study data published in *Tobacco Control* <u>observed</u> no significant differences between the cessation rates of cigarette smokers who used e-cigarettes, nicotine replacement therapy, or nonnicotine replacement therapy medication. However, 37.6% of those who used e-cigarettes became dual users and none switched exclusively to ecigarettes.
