National Conference on Tobacco or Health – National Network of Public Health Institutes New Orleans

- CDC, in collaboration with the Center for Public Health Systems Science at Washington University in St.
   Louis, released a user guide to assist commercial tobacco control staff and partners in implementing comprehensive tobacco control policies and evidencebased intervention.
- CDC <u>published</u> a Health Equity Guiding Principles for Inclusive Communication resource to emphasize the importance of addressing all communities in an inclusive and respectful manner.
- The following announcements come from FDA:
  - o FDA announced that it has authorized marketing of three new e-cigarette products from the R.J. Reynolds Brand Vuse—marking the first products ever to be authorized through the Premarket Tobacco Product Application pathway. Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids published a comprehensive analysis of this action, underscoring the ongoing need for state and local policy efforts to regulate flavored tobacco products.
  - FDA <u>approved</u> marketing applications for Verve brand discs and chews.
  - FDA released a new tobacco compliance webinar for manufacturers and importers that reviews section 905 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and the new electronic submission system, Tobacco Registration and Product Listing Module Next Generation.
- The CDC Foundation <u>published</u> multiple data briefs with updates on population trends in unit sales of e-cigarettes in the United States by product and flavor.
- Truth Initiative <u>presents</u> a quarterly breakdown of the current state of U.S. jurisdictions on policy

- Rescue Agency <u>shares</u> how to utilize behavior change marketing to break the association between tobacco use and rural lifestyles and develop effective vaping, chew, and smoking prevention campaigns for rural teens.

### **State News**

- California Governor Gavin Newsom <u>signed</u> into law a bill that imposes a 12.5% sales tax on ecigarette products, which is projected to generate \$38.4 million for public health education programs by 2023.
- A new Minnesota Department of Health web page <u>discusses</u> the need for an inclusive commercial tobacco prevention movement as American Indian communities face health inequities driven by tobacco access restrictions and marketing policy.
- A Tobacco Control analysis of underage cigar use and cigar marketing locations in eight California cities found a positive association between exposure to tobacco marketing and the odds of cigar use.

in workplaces, tribal casinos, and other public spaces.

- The San Francisco Examiner details the rise and fall of Juul Labs as a local start-up, discussing the company's quick expansion before local and federal regulations threaten to permanently curtail their sales.
- Puff Bar disposable e-cigarette products are now <u>enjoying</u> greater popularity among school-aged consumers than Juul and continue to be marketed and sold with kid-appealing flavors.



- A Nicotine & Tobacco Research longitudinal analysis of Monitoring the Future study data <u>found</u> that a one-dollar increase in cigarette pack price is associated with an average of 72% decreased odds of cigarette initiation and 70% decreased odds of progression to daily cigarette smoking.
- A Tobacco Control systematic review of studies reduced nicotine cigarette marketing <u>found</u> that such marketing often elicits favorable responses from consumers, and might need to be countered with communications campaigns to accurately convey the risk of these products.
- A qualitative analysis of 61 adults from the Atlanta area published in *Nicotine & Tobacco* Research concluded that tobacco smokers were driven to smoke more as a result of COVID-19, reporting no motivation to quit, while e-cigarette users reported vaping less during the initial months of the pandemic response.
