- The following announcements are from Truth Initiative:
 - o Higher e-cigarette prices and taxes can reduce the number of days teens use e-cigarettes and decrease current e-cigarette use, according to Truth Initiative analysis of 2015–2019 Youth Risk Behavior Survey data published in the American Journal of Preventive Medicine.
 - The EX Program highlights an overlooked benefit that can give employee mental health a significant boost: a program that actively engages employees in quitting all forms of tobacco.
 - According to Truth Initiative, the tobacco industry has used women's suffrage and equality movements to market cigarettes to women since the 1920s and is now relying on the same tactics to market e-cigarettes to women by using images and phrases that convey independence, glamour, fun, and health-consciousness.

- Kansas Governor, Laura Kelly, signed legislation raising the age to purchase tobacco products from 18 to 21.
- A bill in Hawaii to undo preemption <u>died despite</u>
 passage in the Senate because it was not
 scheduled for a hearing in the House Finance
 Committee by April 6.
- Idaho Governor, Brad Little, signed into law H.B.
 330 which caps the tax on cigars to 50 cents per cigar.

Research

A Nicotine & Tobacco Research analysis of electronically referred patients found that of all patients referred, the UC Quits <u>quitline contacted</u> 47.1%, 20.6% <u>completed intake</u>, 15.2% <u>requested counseling</u>, and 10.9% <u>received it</u>. Among referred patients completing intake (n = 4264), 46.2% were nonwhite, 58.8% had Medicaid, 58.7% had a chronic disease, and 48.8% had a behavioral health
