 <u>Reynolds Vapor Company</u> for six flavored e cigarette products under its Vuse Alto brand, which
 includes three menthol-flavored and three mixed
 berry-flavored products, with each flavor being
 offered in three nicotine strengths.
- The following announcements are from Truth Initiative:
 - To illustrate how vaping nicotine can intensify symptoms of depression and anxiety and interfere with sleep, **Truth**Initiative teamed up with actor and comedian Chris Parnell in its latest effort Toxic Therapy from Your Vape.

- American Academy of Pediatrics is excited to announce a new clinical decision
 resource: Youth Tobacco Cessation Progressive
 Web App (PWA). The PWA is intended to assist physicians and other clinicians in supporting youth tobacco cessation by delivering the Ask-Counsel-Treat model in a tool designed for use within a clinical encounter.
- Rescue Agency developed a new message package called "<u>Choose Not Worse</u>," which addresses a common trend of teens turning to vapes to cope with increasing stress and anxiety, as part of its ready-made media campaign. Behind the Haze.
- The American Dental Association's Council on Advocacy for Access and Prevention, in collaboration with the North American Quitline Consortium, developed the Implementing & Fostering QuitLine Referrals: A Guide for Oral Health Professionals toolkit, which offers dentists guidance on managing and how to refer patients to state quitLines to support tobacco and vaping cessation efforts.

State News

- The city council in Honolulu, Hawaii passed a bill which would prohibit the sale of flavored tobacco products—except hookah, premium cigars, and loose-leaf tobacco—if and when a state law that preempts localities from regulating or restricting the sale and use of tobacco products is overturned or suspended. The bill now moves to the mayor's desk for consideration.
- Governor Newsom of California signed into law a bill which authorizes the Department of Health and

Request for Application - CG 24-10002 The Statewide End to California's Tobacco Epidemic

This RFA will fund up to three (3) Statewide Technical Assistant Providers (Statewide Providers) grants, one to provide specialized support for each of the following focus areas: 1) Community Engagement and Organizing, 2) Policy Development and Implementation, and 3) Youth and Young Adult Advocacy. The purpose of the Statewide Providers is to foster

In the News

A Hickory Daily Record article discusses a new study which concluded <u>smoking and being exposed</u> to cigarette <u>smoke during pregnancy</u> as significant risk factors for premature and low birthweight babies.

Research

- An analysis published in Tobacco
 Control characterizes the environmental hazards of
 e-liquid chemicals and provides regulators and
 researchers a readily available list for future
 ecological and health risk assessments.
- A special communication published in *Tobacco Control* summarizes the history, marketing, industry deceptions, ecotoxicity, and misunderstandings regarding cellulose acetate filters.
- A Nicotine & Tobacco Control analysis examining purchasing experiences in relation to store characteristics, clerk interactions, and buyer identities, identified four themes: non-chain stores lacked consistency in verifying age; female data collectors experienced uncomfortable situations more frequently than male data collectors; not identifying with the store's typical demographics impacted purchase attempts; and participants suggested improvements for inspections and research during training.
