Deadline: April 23

The Rutgers Institute for Nicotine and Tobacco Studies Center for Rapid Surveillance of Tobacco (CRST) is collecting information related to state tobacco age of sale inspections. They would like to hear states' responses to the following questions:

1. Is your state still funded to do the inspections?
2. Is your state still doing the inspections? Which agency conducts the inspections in your state?
3. To whom is your state reporting data to? (e.g., SAMHSA, CDC?)

Funding Opportunities

[Tobacco/Vape-Free College Program](#) – Truth Initiative

Deadline: April 24

The Truth Initiative Tobacco/Vape-Free College Program is offering grants of up to \$20,000 to colleges and universities to support the adoption and implementation of a 100% tobacco/vape-free policy. Grantees of the Tobacco/Vape-Free College Program receive guidance through webinars, an in-person training, and one-on-one consultations throughout the grant period. Since 2015, the Tobacco/Vape-Free College Program has provided funding to more than 220 colleges, universities, and college systems to advocate for and adopt a 100% tobacco-free policy.

[Quit & Thrive Challenge: Community-Derived Solutions to Reduce Menthol Cigarette Smoking](#) – ODP and CDC

- [In a unanimous decision](#), the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that the FDA followed the law in denying marketing applications for nicotine e-liquids with blatantly kid-friendly flavors.
- A recent **Truth Initiative** article highlights that while current teen e-cigarette use decreased from 2.13 million users in 2023 to 1.63 million in 2024, [young adults ages 18-24 now have the highest prevalence of e-cigarette use](#), and this age group is also reporting high rates of anxiety and depression.
- In a [recent blog](#), Rachael Joyner of the **Duke Smoking Cessation Program** addresses some of the top questions she gets about nicotine patches.

State News

- A federal judge upheld a **Utah** state law [prohibiting the sale of flavored e-cigarettes](#) (excluding tobacco and menthol), allowing the state to begin

Deadline: Sept. 2
 ODP and CDC are sponsoring Quit & Thrive Challenge: Community-Derived Solutions to Reduce Menthol Cigarette Smoking to enhance the evidence base of interventions to help individuals from populations experiencing health disparities quit smoking, with a specific emphasis on menthol cigarettes. The Challenge encourages submissions from local and state organizations and agencies to highlight promising community-led solutions to address menthol cigarette smoking. Up to nine prizes of \$100,000 each will be awarded to organizations with the most successful or innovative community-led strategies.

enforcing the law.

- The **Connecticut** legislature's Public Health Committee [approved a bill to increase the amount of Tobacco Settlement Fund proceeds](#) that must be annually directed to the Tobacco and Health Trust Fund to be used for tobacco prevention and cessation. The bill now moves to the House floor for consideration.
- The **Kentucky** legislature [passed a bill to require licenses for tobacco retailers](#), giving the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control inspection and enforcement powers over them. The bill now moves to the governor's desk for consideration.
- [H.2482](#) was introduced in **Massachusetts** to prohibit the sale of tobacco products on the internet.
- The **Nebraska** state legislature is [advancing a bill](#) that would define "alternative nicotine products" and "nicotine analogs" in state law and add a 20% wholesale excise tax on

- [H5770](#) was introduced in **Rhode Island**, which would reduce the cigarette tax by 75% for any modified risk tobacco product.
- **North Carolina** lawmakers [introduced HB 430, which aims to raise the legal sales age of tobacco products to age 21](#) and to require a tobacco retail sales permit.

Research

- An *American Cancer Society* analysis of National Center for Health Statistics mortality data as a measure of progress in cancer prevention through tobacco control found that [approximately 4 million lung cancer deaths were averted during 1970–2022](#), with an average of 19.8 person-years of life gained per averted death.
